

White Township Code Chapter 257-2 Mandatory Recycling sets requirements within the township.

Residential Requirements

It is mandatory for all persons who are owners, lessees and occupants of residential property to separate aluminum, clear glass, colored glass, newsprint, and acceptable No. 1 and 2 plastics from all other solid waste produced for collection and ultimate recycling of said materials.

It is also mandatory for all persons who are owners, lessees and occupants of residential property to separate leaf waste from all other solid waste produced by such residence.

Non-Residential Requirements

It is mandatory for all owners, lessees, and occupants of commercial, municipal, or institutional establishments to separate leaf waste, aluminum, corrugated paper, high-grade office paper, clear glass, and colored glass from all other solid waste produced by such nonresidential establishment for collection and the ultimate recycling of such material. This requirement also pertains to community activities, such as fairs and organized sporting events.

A commercial, municipal or institutional establishment may be exempted from participating in the Township sponsored recycling program if the establishment:

- (1) Has provided on its own for recycling of the required materials identified above.
- (2) Has provided to White Township or designated agent (Indiana County Solid Waste Authority) on or before February 1 of each year documentation of the weight of the various materials recycled during the period January 1 to December 31 of the preceding year. Documentation for all recycled tonnage must include copies of records originating from either the entity collecting the commercial materials (hauler), or the entity accepting the commercial materials (market). This documentation could include weight slips, market receipts, or signed hauler and market reports verifying all tonnage claims.
