

RESOLUTION No. R-2 -17

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WHITE, COUNTY OF INDIANA AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, ACKNOWLEDGING THE MODIFICATION THE WHITE TOWNSHIP AGRICULTURAL SECURITY AREA

WHEREAS, the White Township Board of Supervisors have established an Agricultural Security Area consisting of parcels of land located in White Township, as set forth in White Township Resolution No R-2-16, all in accordance with the Act of June 30, 1981, P.L. 128, No 43, known as the “Agricultural Area Security Law”, and

WHEREAS, on June 9,2016 Andy Fabin, FBF Transport LLC. located at 231 Bethel Church Road Indiana, PA submitted a letter to White Township requesting inclusion into the existing White Township Agricultural Security Area; and

WHEREAS, Section 908 (a) of the Agricultural Area Security Law states, in part, that “...The governing body shall act to adopt or reject the proposal, or any modification, no later than 180 days from the date the proposal was originally submitted. Failure by the governing body to act within this 180-day period shall be deemed adoption of the proposal without modification.”; and

WHEREAS, the White Township Board of Supervisors did not act on the proposal within the established 180-day time frame; and

WHEREAS, the White Township Board of Supervisors acknowledges and agrees with the 180-day time frame stipulation; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of the Township of White does hereby agree to the modification of the Agricultural Security Area within the Township of White in accordance with the provisions of the “Agricultural Area Security Law” of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Act of June 30, 1981, P.L. 128, No. 43 adding the following property within the Township of White, as follows:

That the Owners of the premises herein described, and the premises herein described shall be subject to and be entitled to the benefit of the Agricultural Area Security Law of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, (Act of June 30, 1981, P.L. 128 No. 43 (3 P.S. 901 et sec.)
